1	Gen 1:1	In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
2	Gen 1:27	So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them.
3	Ps 19:1	The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.
4	Heb 11:1	Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.
5	Heb 11:6	And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
6	Eph 2:8-9	8 For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— 9 not by works, so that no one can boast.
7	Rom 10:17	Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.
8	2 Tim 3:16-17	16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, 17 so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
9	Heb 4:12	For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
10	Isa 55:8-9	8 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the LORD. 9 "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."
11	Ps 18:30	As for God, his way is perfect: The Lord's word is flawless; he shields all who take refuge in him.
12	Josh 1:8	Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
13	John 1:1	In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
14	Matt 24:35	Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
15	John 3:16-17	16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him.
16	John 11:25	Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies;
17	John 5:24	"I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.

24	Prov 3:5-8	5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; 6 in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. 7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil. 8 This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.

25	Matt 22:37-40	37 Jesus replied: " Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'
26	John 13:35	By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.
27	1 John 3:16	This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.
28	John 15:13	Greater love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends.

34	Col 3:12	Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
35	Mic 6:8	He has showed you, O man, what is good. And what does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.
36	Phil 4:8	Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.
37	Rom 15:13	May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
38	Eph 2:10	For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

42	Matt 11:29-30	29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.
43	Isa 26:3	You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.
44	1 Pet 3:15-16	15 But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect, 16 keeping a clear conscience, so that those who speak maliciously against your good behavior in Christ may be ashamed of their slander.
45	Gal 2:20	I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

70	Acts 18:9	One night the Lord spoke to Paul in a vision: "Do not be afraid; keep on speaking, do not be silent.
71	Acts 18:11	So Paul stayed for a year and a half, teaching them the word of God.
72	Jas 1:12	Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him.

80	1 Pet 5:7	Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.
81	2 Cor 12:9	But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.
82	Heb 4:16	Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
83	Heb 13:5	Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

85	Heb 4:15	For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet was without sin.
86	Rom 6:23	For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
87	Rom 5:8	But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
88	2 Cor 5:21	God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
89	1 Pet 2:24	He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.
90	Isa 53:5	But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

93	Ps 103:1-5	1 Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. 2 Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits -- 3 who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, 4 who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, 5 who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.
94	2 Pet 1:3-4	3 His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. 4 Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.
95	John 10:10	The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
